# **Deliverable Description**

The system will add online application functionality to the existing grantee toolset.

# **Goals and Objectives**

## Goal 1: Allow Agencies to create/publish electronic applications to the CSFA

#### Objectives

- Integrate existing Agency opportunity creation frontend GATA system with AmpliFund
- Allow GATA system users to access AmpliFund via existing GATA system
- Allow State Agency users to log in to AmpliFund with Single Sign On (SSO) via Illinois.gov login

## Goal 2: Ensure Agency compliance with State GATA frameworks

#### Objectives

- Create an electronic application template to standardize the collection of application data
- Identify and define standard and optional sections of the application that are required under the GATA framework
- Define security requirements and ability for users to edit form template sections

## Goal 3: Enable grantees to access, complete, and submit applications

#### **Objectives**

- Ensure there is no loss in existing grantee portal functionality for grantee registration and pre-qualification
- Link to electronic application in AmpliFund from the CSFA site and enable seamless grantee SSO
- Sync grantee and additional users and roles between AP and GATA active directories
- Validate grantee eligibility

# Goal 4: Implement a consistent, standardized, and centralized user experience for grantee users

#### Objectives

- Add section to grants.illinois.gov that displays application status information pulled via API from AmpliFund
- Allow customization of AmpliFund applicant portal for a consistent user experience and state agency branding

# **Impact**

## **Technical Considerations**

- 1. How will AmpliFund capture edits to NOFO after publication
- 2. Will need to determine grantee security model and map to AmpliFund security model
- 3. Will need to add API call from GATA system to AmpliFund to create a linked opportunity in AmpliFund; return an ID upon successful save that can be used by the GATA system to generate a link to the opportunity in AmpliFund
- 4. Will need to understand application fields and mapping to AmpliFund
- 5. Will need to add API call from GATA system interface to display a link in the opportunity details allowing the opportunity manager to access the opportunity in AmpliFund
- 6. Will need to determine to what extent the individual agencies can configure their own sections and forms

# **Implementation Considerations**

- 1. Will need agencies to participate in requirements gathering workshop sessions
- 2. Will need enforcement of GATA standards
- 3. Will need GATU participating in early agency requirement gathering process to understand GATA standard grant application in combination with agency specifics and AmpliFund configuration
- 4. Will need to do significant requirements gathering and possible changes to the GATA site based on findings of BAs
- 5. Will need to consider merit-based review during application creation

# **Assumptions**

- 1. StreamLink is responsible for AmpliFund API and GATU/DoIT is responsible for GATA API
- 2. StreamLink will create development and staging sites on MS Azure for GATA sites
- 3. State Agencies will have one core application
- 4. Currently there are differences in applications
- 5. NOFO will be source of record for opportunity details
- 6. Existing registration and pre-qualification processes of grantees/applicants will not change
- 7. Grantee and State Agency active directories will not change
- 8. All agencies are responsible for creation and testing of agency-specific forms

## **Open Items to Discuss**

- 1. Determine database of registered applicants to be leveraged during application process. Will there be a switch to a new government directory, i.e. login.gov?
- 2. To what extent the individual agencies can configure their own sections and forms?
- 3. Who is the DoIT SSO contact?
